RESOLUTION NO. 2023-093

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RATES TO BE CHARGED IN 2024 THROUGH 2028 FOR WATER AND WATER RECLAMATION UTILITY SERVICES

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority granted to it by state law, the City of Rapid City has established and operates a municipal water system; and

WHEREAS, the City's water utility is funded as an enterprise fund which economically supports itself without the use of the City's other funds; and

WHEREAS, the funds required to build, operate and maintain the City's water system are generated solely through the rates and fees charged to the utility's customers; and

WHEREAS, the City has undertaken a comprehensive rate study to determine the appropriate rates to fund the costs of providing water service to its customers; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it to be in the best interests of the City and its citizens to adopt an updated comprehensive fee resolution;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City of Rapid City that the following fees are established and will be effective January 1, 2024:
