Monday holidays: set your can out on Tuesday. All other days set out normal

Friday holidays: Monday set out as normal, all other days set out one day earlier

Leave out all containers until collected, even if it's the next day

COLLECTIONS

- All containers must be out by 7am with arrows on the lid facing the street/alley
- Containers must be four feet from mailboxes, utility poles, fences, cars, etc
- All trash and recycled material must be bagged and tied
 - No construction debris, carpet, lumber, sod, hot ash or yard waste inside the containers

Cardboard must be taken to one of the drop off sites, it cannot go in the blue bins. Only corrugated cardboard is recycled, please do not put any shiny cardboard in the containers (diaper boxes, cereal boxes, soda boxes, etc)

Curbside yard waste and remote site yard waste containers will start on May 1st.
