

HOLIDAYS

Good Friday : **Friday, April 7th**

Memorial Day : **Monday, May 29th**

Juneteenth: **Monday, June 19th**

Independence Day : **Tuesday, July 4th**
(Tuesdays set out on Wednesday, all other days set out normal)

Labor Day : **Monday, September 4th**

Native American Day: **Monday, October 9th**

Veterans Day : **Friday, November 10th**

Thanksgiving Day : **Thursday, November 23rd**

(Monday & Friday set out normal, all other days set out one day earlier)

Christmas Day : **Monday, December 26th**

New Year's Day : **Monday, January 1st, 2024**

Monday holidays: set your can out on **Tuesday**. All other days set out normal

Friday holidays: Monday set out as normal, all other days **set out one day earlier**

Leave out all containers until collected, even if it's the next day

COLLECTIONS

- All containers must be out by 7am with arrows on the lid facing the street/alley
- Containers must be four feet from mailboxes, utility poles, fences, cars, etc
- All trash and recycled material must be bagged and tied
 - No construction debris, carpet, lumber, sod, **hot ash** or yard waste inside the containers

Cardboard must be taken to one of the drop off sites, it cannot go in the blue bins. Only corrugated cardboard is recycled, please do not put any shiny cardboard in the containers (diaper boxes, cereal boxes, soda boxes, etc)

Curbside yard waste and remote site yard waste containers will start on May 1st.

RECYCLING CHEAT SHEET

DO'S

All of these can go in the blue container:

glass bottles & jars
aluminum food cans/bottles
hairspray & shaving cream cans
vegetable/soup cans
empty paint & aerosol cans
milk jugs
detergent bottles
soda & water bottles
plastics #1-7

DONT'S

Please do not recycle:

styrofoam
shiny cardboard
plastic bags
pyrex
light bulbs
window glass
aluminum foil/pie tins
packing peanuts
hangers
pots and pans
mirrors
